**JAMES CACCAMO, PH.D.**

Jim Caccamo is Associate Professor of Theology at Saint Joseph's University in Philadelphia (PA) where he teaches Christian social ethics. Former choir director and computer programmer, Jim's work focuses on the implications of technology and media on spiritual and moral practices. His current work focuses on the ethics of information and communication technologies. At present, he is working on the book *Rewiring Virtue*, a virtue ethics technology use.

Since 2001 he has worked as an associate professor for the College of Communication and the Arts at Seton Hall University (NJ), where he teaches *Writing for the Organization and the Client*, among other courses. He is also the coordinator for the College's Institute for Communication and Religion, which provides a nexus for scholarly exploration of communication topics critically important to religion and society.

**JOE OWENS**

In 2017, Joe was named editor and general manager of *The Dialog* in the Diocese of Wilmington (DE).
