Ordained a priest for the Dublin Diocese in 1983, Paul Tighe served as a Lecturer of Moral Theology at Mater Dei Institute of Education in Dublin and at Holy Cross College. In 2004 he was named Director of Communications for the diocese, where he also established an Office for Public Affairs. In November 2007 Pope Benedict XVI appointed him as Secretary of the Pontifical Council for Social Communications. In 2015 Pope Francis appointed him as titular Bishop of Drivastrum and Adjunct Secretary of the Pontifical Council for Culture. He then became Secretary in 2017.
