The John Cardinal Foley Chair of Homiletics & Social Communications was inaugurated in 2013-2014 and became a full-time position in 2017-2018 with the appointment of REV. THOMAS DAILEY, O.S.F.S. to the Seminary's faculty. The report below chronicles the programming supported by the Cardinal Foley Chair and the work of Fr.
