

- 1. "I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life."
- 2. "I will establish peace in their homes."
- 3. "I will comfort them in their afflictions."
- 4. "I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all in death."
- 5. "I will bestow a large blessing upon all their undertakings."
- 6. "Sinners shall find in My Heart the source and the infinite ocean of mercy."
- 7. "Tepid souls shall grow fervent."
- 8. "Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection."
- 9. "I will bless every place where a picture of My Heart shall be set up and honored."
- 10. "I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts."
- 11. "Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be blotted out."
- 12. "I promise thee in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who communicate on the First Friday in nine consecutive months, the grace of final pen itence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving the Sacraments; My Divine heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment."
