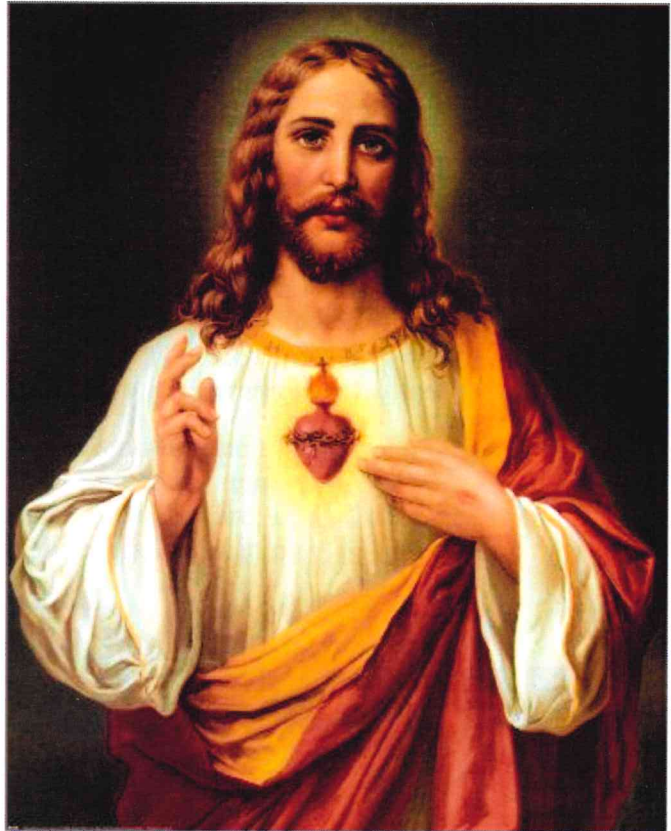

16th Century*

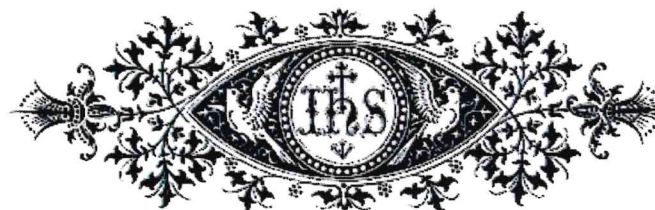
O come, divine Messiah!
