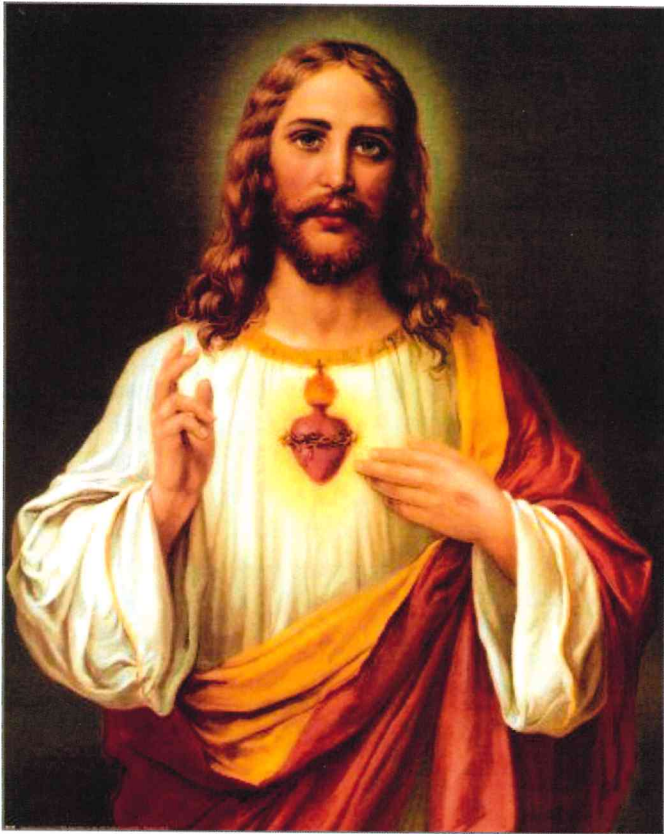

7. *"Tepid souls shall grow fervent."*
8. *"Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection."*
9. *"I will bless every place where a picture of My Heart shall be set up and honored."*
10. *"I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts."*
11. *"Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be blotted out."*
12. *"I promise thee in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who communicate on the First Friday in nine consecutive months, the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving the Sacraments; My Divine heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment."*
