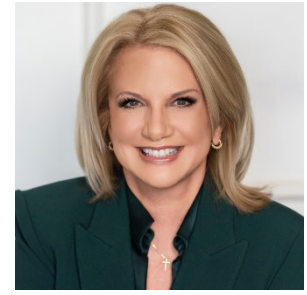




*The 2026 John Cardinal Foley Award

For more than thirty years, **TRACY DAVIDSON** has been connecting with people in the region and beyond by communicating stories that truly matter.

She joined NBC10 News in March 1996, after starting her career as a radio host in upstate New York. In Philadelphia, she first served as an investigative consumer reporter and more recently has been the co-anchor of the weekday newscasts at 4pm and 5pm. Having represented the station at hundreds of community and charity events in the area, she retired from NBC Philadelphia in the fall of 2025.

For her journalistic work, she has earned eleven Emmy Awards, including the prestigious Best News Anchor Emmy for the Mid-Atlantic Region in 2008 and 2013. She also received the Lew Klein Alumni in Media award from Temple University (2014) and was inducted into the Hall of Fame of the Broadcast Pioneers of Philadelphia (2015).

Numerous business and social organizations have conferred honors on her, including a designation among Pennsylvania's Most Powerful and Influential Women in 2013. She has also received three honorary doctoral degrees, from Neumann University (2011), Manor College (2022), and Chestnut Hill College (2024).

Her mission of service now extends to advocating for important social causes, especially the empowerment of women, both personally and professionally. A TedX presenter and frequent keynote speaker, she shares skills and stories that help audiences strengthen resilience, lead with authenticity, and serve others with empathy.

She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in broadcasting, telecommunications and mass media from Temple University (2006), a certificate in religious studies from Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary (2008), and a Master of Arts degree in holistic spirituality from Chestnut Hill College (2014).

She is a member of St. Dennis parish in Havertown and maintains a strong following on social media.
